The Privacy Amendment Act 2012 (No. 197, 2012), has passed through the Australian Parliament taking effect on 12 March 2014. The new legislation introduces significant obligations for the protection of personal information held by Australian organisations, and material financial penalties of up to 1.7 Million.

Organisations that collect and or hold personal information are required to comply with the Privacy Act 1988 and its Amendments. Privacy Amendment (Enhancing Privacy Protection) Act 2012 (No. 197, 2012) introduces the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs) which includes, "APP11 – Security of Personal Information".

Australian Privacy Act Security Requirements Workshop

Recent changes to the Australian Privacy Act places significant responsibilities on to organisations for the protection of personal information against unauthorised use, manipulation and access. These new responsibilities include the potential for fines of up to \$1.7million and the compulsory notification of all impacted parties.



The IPsec Australian Privacy Act Security Requirements Workshop is designed to provide your organisation with an updated understanding of the new privacy act requirements for personal information security. Additionally the workshop is designed to brief your organisation on the types of steps and security initiatives that should be adopted to avoid either a breach of the new requirements and/or to reduce the potential of significant penalties being applied.

The Privacy Strategy Workshop is typically one half-day (3-4 hours) discussion depending on the number of stakeholders and the size of the organisation's information environment.
